JINGLE IN THE CITY

Characters: *indicates a singing role

<u>The Orphans</u> – A group of five orphans from age 7 to 15 who have adopted each other as family (all orphan vocal ranges from *A below middle C to high E*)

Georgie* Female, about 15 years old. The leader of this little band of homeless children; she's tough but has a tender heart. She sees it as her job to take care of the others.

Stewart* Male, about 14 years old. Stewart's fear and loneliness come out as anger. He pretends to older and tougher than he is. (

Harvey* Male, about 11 years old. Harvey is the clown of the group, often getting himself into and out of trouble.

Clara* Female, about 10 years old. Clara misses her parents and believes that they will come to find her. She is caught between childlike innocence and the tough realities of her life. (

Lily* Female, about 7 years old. Georgie's little sister is the youngest but most open of the group.

<u>The Honeycutts</u> – Mid 30's to 40ish, they are a childless couple with tender hearts. They own the store in which the children take shelter

Jonas A thin man with spectacles and a Mr. Rogers sweater; he is a respected member of the community and would love to be a father.

Mrs. Honeycutt* A small and roundish woman, she is comforting and warm. (Vocal Range: *G below middle C to high E*)

<u>The Latvian Children</u> – Immigrants from Latvia, they are waiting for the parents to join them in America. They befriend and help the orphans.

Oskar Male, about 15 years old; willing to stand up to Georgie.

Brigita Female, about 17 years old; she is motherly toward the little girls.

<u>The Policemen</u> – They are eager but bumbling police officers. Think "The Three Stooges". (non-speaking roles)

Officer Mole The man in charge

Officers Lawrence and Curtis

Other Members of the Community -

Viola Pillow* Female, no specific age; the headmistress of the Manhattan School for Orphans, she is a proper society woman who has a tender heart for underprivileged children. (Vocal Range: *G below middle C to high E*)

Mayor Tisdale Male, no specific age; the mayor of NYC is a distinguished, proper man.

Jerry Edwards Male, no specific age; he's the radio announcer who acts as MC for the parade.

Vendor Brooklyn born and bred so he needs a Brooklyn accent; he pretends to be old

and crippled

Townspeople and Other Officers—A group of 30-40 adults, both men and women

Children and Teenage Hoodlums – 15 to 20 roles for boys and girls from age 7 to 18
